The College is the Guest House of Fscire.

It is not a B&B, nor a student house, nor a hostel.

It is a venue for the short stays of colleagues in a spirit of mutual helpfulness.

The college is a smoke-free zone, as are all other areas of Fscire.

Cameras and wi-fi access (which passwords are in the rooms) are monitored for security reasons

Access and security

During the opening hours of the library it is possible to collect the keys to the door of no. 116 and to the room from the reception producing a valid ID document, against the payment of a deposit. The external door must always be locked, both on the entering and leaving. Forgetting to do so will result in losing the permission to reside in the College.

Failure to return the keys will preclude the possibility of staying at the College again.

Rooms and bathrooms

Fscire guarantees weekly cleaning of all the spaces of the College.

For personal needs, the laundries in Via San Vitale or Strada Maggiore can be used.

For the safety of the guests, no iron or drying racks may be brought into the College.

To ensure the hygiene of the facilities, each bathroom is provided with cleaning products.

Reading room (1st floor)

There is a living room for reading, conversation and study on the first floor.

No food can be consumed in the reading room

Breakfast and lunch room (2nd floor)

A communal table with its own tableware is located on the second floor.

Use of the kitchen is allowed between the hours of 6.00 to 9.00, 12.00 to 15.00, and 19.00 to 22.00.

Crockery (plates, glasses, cups, pots, and cutlery) is located in the cupboard and should be washed and put away after every use.

To avoid damaging tables and shelves, the available table mats and trivets can be used.

Condiments and spices can be found in the cabinet to the upper left of the sink.

The only cookware that can be used on the induction stove is on the bottom shelf.

Containers for storing foods in the refrigerator are on the shelf above the cooker.

Food due to expire in less than 30 days should be thrown away or taken with you before leaving the room, otherwise it will be disposed of in the weekly cleaning.

Green policy and waste disposal

The college is supplied with small security lights for the night.

Three recycling bins are located in the hall of the second floor.

Dumpsters on the streets can be used for waste that needs to be disposed of quickly.
